

Introduction

Wodonga Council's water tower lights are designed to activate the night landscape of the central business area with colourful and changing features.

They are programmed to move through a range of general colours and may at times be used to promote significant council events or activities, or major national awareness campaigns.

The Cube Wodonga's Technical Co-ordinator is responsible for developing and implementing an annual schedule for the water tower lights.

Applications for use

To request a specific change to the water tower lighting programming, applicants must mail or email a request to the Technical Co-ordinator at The Cube Wodonga.

The request must be submitted at least one month prior to the anticipated display date.

Eligibility

Applications to light the water tower need to meet one of the following criteria:

- Be part of a social awareness media campaign (for example pink for cancer awareness);
- Reference a specific event (for example the use the colours of company/logo to match an event occurring in The Cube Wodonga or The Cube Wodonga Courtyard);
- Promote The Cube Wodonga events; or,
- Promote Wodonga Council events.

Applications will not be accepted if the initiative demonstrates political intent. Wodonga Council reserves the right to veto in regard to the type of programming to be displayed on the water tower.

Changing colour of water tower lights

Only authorised council staff can change the colour of the water tower lights, taking into consideration a safe working environment at all times.
